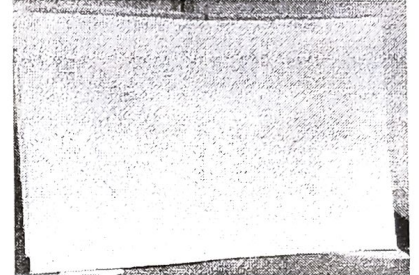
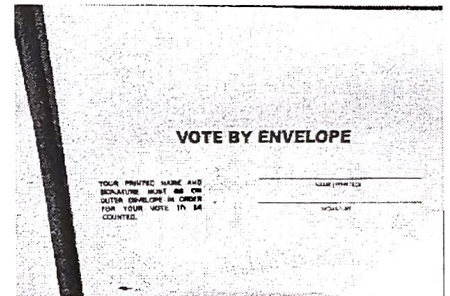


INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE DOUBLE ENVELOPE BALLOT PROCESS

STEP 1: Mark the ballot with your choice. Then, fold your completed ballot and place into **small plain white** envelope. Seal the envelope.



STEP 2: Insert plain white envelope from Step 1 into the larger envelope. **Seal this larger envelope.**



STEP 3: Turn the larger envelope over and complete the required information in the spaces provided:

- a) Print your name (legibly)
- b) Your signature
- c) Date

STEP 4: Give your ballot to your OEA site representative.

Strike Authorization Vote FAQ

Who is eligible to vote?

All OEA members (AC) are eligible to vote.

If I'm not a member, can become a member and vote?

Yes, if you are a non-member (NM), you may obtain an application from your site rep, complete it, and then cast a vote. (Please turn in your application and ballot to your site rep.)

Where can we vote if I'm at not a site, I'm at more than one site, or work at a non-voting location?

Any member (AC) may vote at any school site or at the OEA Office (272 E 12th St) from 10am to 6pm, Tuesday- Thursday, and 10 am to 7pm on Friday

What if my name is not on the site roster?

You will cast a "challenge ballot" and membership will be verified by the Elections Committee. All site reps will have enough ballots to accommodate. If you are a member, your vote will COUNT!

***** Please note: If a member casts two "challenge ballots," none will be counted. *****
